## About "Let's go 2 school"

### • We love practising our English

Our passion is English, but we are also passionate about education. So, along with learning English, we are raising funds to build a school in Laos with the help of a US-based educational non-profit organization called Pencils of Promise (PoP).

### • Who we are

We are a group of more than a hundred adult learners and native and non-native teachers of English, dedicated to communication, improving our language skills and getting to know each other.

Our community is a safe environment where you can meet like-minded people from all over the world.

### • What we do

We run a number of regular activities, such as the Speaking Challenge, Get to Know sessions, Quizzes and Games, Singing classes, Pronunciation and Accuracy sessions, and many more, including special sessions with Christian Saunders of Canguro English!



These sessions are available on most days of the week. If you're unable to participate on the day, don't worry. You can watch the recording later.

## • How it all began – the first school

It was Christian Saunders of Canguro English who started a campaign to raise USD 50k, the amount needed for the building and maintenance of a primary school in Laos, which is one of the poorest countries in the world.

The construction work and the training of the local teachers is carried out by PoP that has already built more than 140 schools in Laos.

At the start of the first project, Christian Saunders asked the members joining to make a USD 100.00 donation and—in exchange, he and other educators pledged to run communication and language learning activities.

We are delighted that we were able to raise the first USD 50k between November 2020 and May 2021.
